□ **Staff Recommendation:**

Staff recommends that Council approve the urgency ordinance extending the temporary moratorium on massage establishments. This extension will prohibit the licensing, permitting and opening of massage establishments within the City and the issuance of permits to massage practitioners for an additional 10 months and 15 days, for a total moratorium period of one year. This extension is needed to provide staff with the necessary time, and for the Planning Commission and the City Council to consider, comprehensive local regulations governing massage establishments and massage practitioners to protect public health, safety and welfare.
